Improvised Amigurumi Pattern by Louie's Loops

In this amigurumi crochet pattern we'll be making the 1 eyed, 2 horned, and 3 legged alien creature, Uno the Fluffalo! This pattern was made from scratch during a live crochet along.

Pattern Info

Materials

- The Yarn (Worsted Weight)
 - Color A (Skin tone)
 - Color B (Fur color)
 - White (Eyes, Teeth and Horns)
 - Pink (Tongue)
 - Brown (Legs)
- Size G6/4.00mm Hook
- 8mm Eye x 1
- Stuffing
- Darning Needle
- Pipe Cleaner x 1



Other Info







This pattern is interactive, featuring checkmarks at pivotal Rounds and sections to keep track of progress. It is best used when opened in a program or app rather than a browser window.

Gauge: 5 Rnds and 4 sts per 1"

Finished Size: about 4 inches long

Worked in the Round (without turning)

The Stitches



ch	Chain Stitch
st	Stitch
Rnd	Round (worked in a spiral)
sc	Single Crochet
slst	Slip Stitch
inc	Increase (sc 2 in 1 st)

hdc	Half-Double Crochet	
dc	Double Crochet	
invdec	Invisible Decrease	
FLO/BLO	Front / Back Loop Only	
bo	Bobble Stitch (4dctog)	
mp	Mini Picot (ch 2, slst in the BLO of the 2nd ch from the hook)	

Where to Start for Beginners

This pattern is **not designed for beginners**. You will probably need some prior experience in crochet to get started with this pattern. I've included a **full length video tutorial for this pattern** (linked on the previous page) that will go through every single stitch and technique needed in detail, I highly encourage crocheting along with that video if you are a complete beginner.

If you need extra help, I've included a few pattern specific tutorials below from my starter series, Crocheting 101: How to Crochet for Complete Beginners. If you're having an exceptionally difficult time, I suggest starting from the beginning of that series to learn all the basics to this awesome craft. You can jump right in by clicking here.

Important Tutorials





How to Crochet the Single Crochet



Step 1:



Insert the hook into the stitch or magic loop.

Step 2:



Yarn over your hook, and pull it through the stitch.

Step 3:



Yarn over and pull through both loops on the stitch.

Snout

[All in Color A] Magic Loop ①

Rnd 1: [sc, hdc into the magic loop] repeat 3 times (6)

{ } = Worked in the same st

Rnd 2: sc 1, {sc 1, hdc 1, sc 1}, sc 1, {sc 1, ch 1, sc 1} sc 1, {sc 1, hdc 1, sc 1} (11)

Cut the yarn leaving a long enough end to sew to the face, pull through, and hide the end.

Eye

[All in White] Magic Loop

Rnd 1: sc 6 in the the magic loop (6)

Rnd 2: [sc, inc] repeat 3 times (9)

Slst 1, cut the yarn leaving a long enough end to sew to the face, pull through, and hide the end. Insert a 10mm eye into the center and secure.



Lip

[All in Color A]

Ch 10, cut the yarn leaving a long enough end to sew to the face and pull through.

Teeth

Make 2

[All in White]

Ch 3, starting in the 2nd ch, working into the back loops, sc 1, hdc 1

Ch 1, cut the yarn and pull through leaving somewhat long ends to use for attaching through 2 adjacent sts under the lip and knotted on the inside.

Tongue

[All in Pink]

Ch 5, skip 2, starting in the 3rd ch, working into the back loops, hdc 2, sc 1,

Ch 1, cut the yarn and pull through leaving somewhat long ends to use for attaching through 2 adjacent sts under the lip and knotted on the inside.

Small Horn

[All in White] Magic Loop

Rnd 1: sc 3 into the magic loop (3)

Rnd 2: inc, sc 2 (4)

Rnd 3: [sc 1, inc 1] 2 times (6)

Sc 1, slst 1, cut the yarn leaving a long enough end to sew to the face and pull through.



Big Horn

[All in Whiti⊕] Magic Loop

Rnd 1: sc 3 into the magic loop (3)

Rnd 2: inc, sc 2 (4)

Rnd 3: [sc 1, inc 1] 2 times (6)

Rnd 4: sc 5, inc (7)

Sc 1, slst 1, cut the yarn leaving a long enough end to sew to the face and pull through.



Make 3

[All in **Brown**] Magic Loop

Rnd 1: sc 8 into the magic loop (8)

Rnd 2: Working into the BLO, sc in each (8)

Slst 1, cut the yarn leaving a long enough end to sew to the body and pull through.



Body

[Starting in Color A] Magic loop

Rnd 1: sc 6 into the magic loop (6)

Rnd 2: inc in each (12)

Rnd 3: [sc 1, inc 1] 6 times (18)


Rnd 4: [sc 2, inc 1] 6 times (24)

Rnd 5: [sc 7, inc 1] 3 times (27)

[Change to Color B]

Rnd 6: [sc 8, inc 1] 3 times (30)

Rnds 7 - 9: sc in each (30 for 3 Rnds)



Rnds 10 - 12: sc in each (30 for 3 Rnds)

Rnd 13: [sc 8, invdec 1] 3 times (27)

Rnd 14: [sc 7, invdec 1] 3 times (24)

Rnd 15: [sc 2, invdec 1] 6 times (18)

Rnd 16: [sc 1, invdec 1] 6 times (12)

Stuff mostly, add a squeeker for added quirkiness.

Rnd 17: invdec in each (6)

Cut the yarn and pull through. Stuff fully and sew closed.

Sew on the legs on the bottom of the body with one in front and two in the back.

Tail and Fluffing

For the tail start by making a small Pom-Pom in Color B.

Place a pipe cleaner through the Pom-Pom and fold in half. Twist the pipe cleaner together, leaving an untwisted inch on the bottom.

Take a long strand of yarn in **Color A** and begin wrapping the yarn ends around the pipe cleaner covering it up. Weave through the tip of the pipe cleaner, and begin wrapping back down the pipe cleaner working back to the base. Try to fully cover the pipe cleaner in yarn (except the untwisted inch at the bottom).

Place the ends of the pipe cleaner through stitches on the back of the Fluffalo. Pull the yarn ends through each stitch on the back and through an adjacent stitch to double knot. Hide the ends on the inside of the body.

Finish your Fluffalo by fluffing the fuzzy Color B yarn using a cat brush or the rough end of some velcro.
